This letter addresses the implementation of the Local Government Assistance Program defined under the rules TAC Title 43, Part 1, Chapter 29. Subchapter A, Rule§ 29.3 (43TAC § 29.3). and the Appropriation Act passed during the 8411, session of the Legislature. The rule requires the Department to give materials to the counties to assist in repairing and maintaining county roads damaged by the impact of the 2060 Weight Tolerance permits.

The FY2026 assistance allotment for Hopkins County is \$20,494. Please see attached a list of Available Material by County for the Paris District for the FY2026 program. It is possible for your county to obtain materials that are shown on the attached spreadsheet that are located in counties other than your own. Please submit a written request for assistance as soon as possible to Tommy Henderson, Director of Operations, Paris District at the below address. This request for material to be distributed in FY2026 should be submitted within 45 days.

After we have received your written request, you will be notified of whom to contact prior to removing the material. The county shall monitor the amount of material removed from department stockpiles and report the information to the applicable maintenance supervisor.

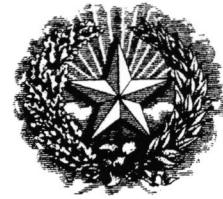


Your request to participate in the County Assistance Program FY26 has been received in our office.
